China Matters is seeking part-time interns. This is an opportunity to gain first-hand experience in a small, dynamic team that focuses on challenging and emerging issues in Australia-China relations. Duties will include:

- Undertaking administrative tasks
- Conducting background research to support China Matters projects and events
- Other tasks as required

The internship will consist of 40 internship days, preferably 3 internship days per week over a period of three-and-a-half months. Please note the internship is unpaid. Expected commencement date: **early May 2017**.

Key Selection Criteria:

- Tertiary studies in Chinese/Asian studies, public policy, international business, international relations, security, or similar
- Demonstrated interest in Australia-China relations relating to international policy and/or business
- Research skills
- Excellent written and oral communication abilities in English
- Strong attention to detail and time management skills
- A self-starter with the ability to work independently with minimal supervision and as part of a team
- Applicant must be based in Sydney for the duration of the internship. China Matters cannot assist with visa procurement

Desirable:

- Chinese reading skills
- Advanced social media experience, include general web page design skills
- Event management and administrative experience
